Green Schools Scholarship Details

The School District Sustainability Scholarship provides targeted education and technical support from the Center and its partners, for staff who spend at least 50% of their time dedicated to fulfilling the district's sustainability objectives. The Scholarship is valued at \$20,000 and includes the following training and benefits:

1. Travel, lodging and attendance for the scholar at the 2019 [Greenbuild International Conference and Expo](#) (Atlanta, November 19-22)
2. Travel, lodging and attendance for the scholar and one colleague at the 2020 [Green Schools Conference](#) (Portland, Oregon, March 2-3)
3. Travel, lodging and attendance for the scholar at the annual summit for School Sustainability Leaders (Hosted in conjunction with the Green Schools Conference, Portland, Oregon, March 4-5)
4. Ongoing training through personal and small group coaching
5. Limited complimentary year-long access to several school resources from USGBC, including [Learning Lab](#), the [Green Classroom Professional Certificate, Arc, and LEED Coach](#) for school projects
